I will not provide access to militarily critical technical data to persons other than their employees or eligible persons designated by the registrant to act on their behalf unless such access is permitted by U.S. DoDD 5230.25, Canada's TDCR, or by the U.S. or Canadian Government agency that provided the technical data.

I am not debarred, suspended, or otherwise ineligible to perform on U.S. or Canadian Government contracts, and have not violated U.S. or contravened Canadian export control laws, and have not had a certification revoked under the provisions of U.S. DoDD 5230.25 or Canada's TDCR.

Prior to or within 24 hours of receiving the UTD or MCTD, I will contact the Export Control Office about scheduling a meeting to review the technical data and to establish a formal technology control plan.
